

Cookie Policy

What are Cookies?

Cookies are small electronic files which a website can transfer to a user's hard drive to identify a user and personalise their use of that website. Our web server automatically collects standard information such as a user's IP address, browser type, operating system, access times, etc.. We do not use cookies to customise web page content.

Google Analytics Cookies

We use Google Analytics software which places cookies on a user's device to provide us with aggregated usage data of this website.

Google Analytics uses first-party cookies to track visitor interactions. These cookies are used to store information, such as what time the current visit occurred, whether the visitor has been to the site before, and what site referred the visitor to the web page. These cookies do not collect information that identifies a visitor. Browsers do not share first-party cookies across domains.

Analytical cookies allow us to count the number of visitors to our website, and to see how users move around the site when they are using it. This helps us to improve the quality of the delivery of our web materials. No personal information is collected or retained by means of the cookies used to generate this statistical information.
